Guarantee: The children who will play on the Tanger Playground and walk around the Park will never remember the names of the donors ... *because they will be too busy having fun.*

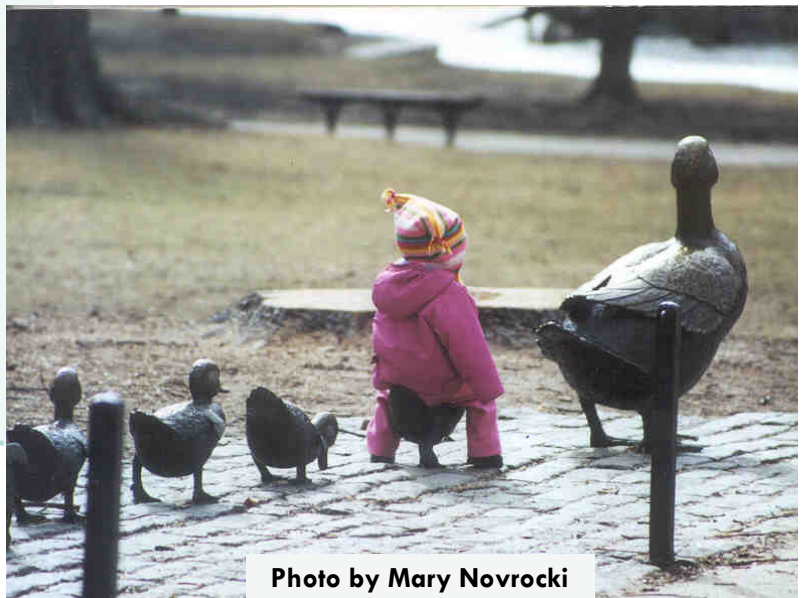
